

Entering pictures on a course homepage

If you want to add a picture to your course homepage you will need to learn and use a little HTML code.

The code you'll need is:

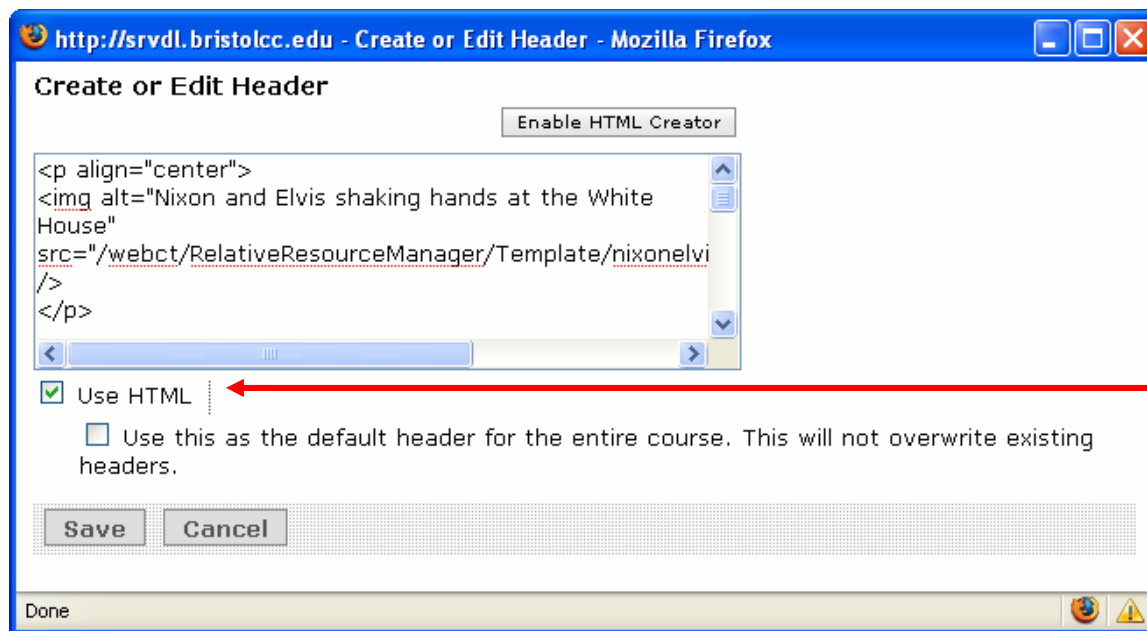

The `<p>` `</p>` tags identify that you want a paragraph (it really just defines the spacing around the image) and the alignment attribute allows you to specify left, right or center.

The `` tag is what you need to reference the image. The `src` attribute is where you indicate the location of the image on the server. We'll look at determining the location of your image on page 2 of this document. The `alt` attribute is where you'll include descriptive text. It's really important to include the `alt` attribute and a clear description for accessibility purposes!

The place where you'll need to enter the HTML code is in the page **Header**.

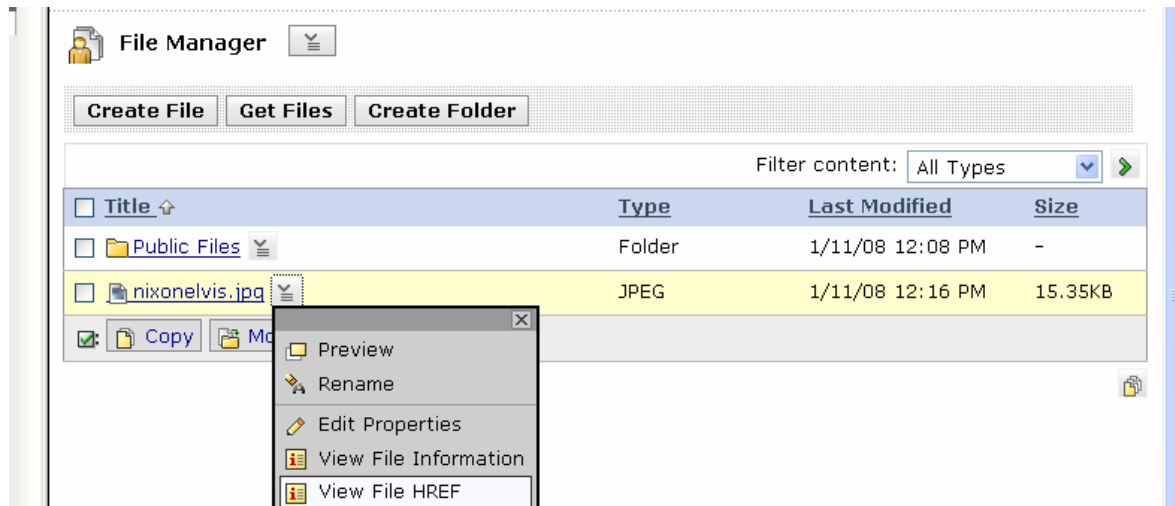
Instead of using the HTML creator it is really just easier to type the code directly in the box. You will need to make sure that the box next to "Use HTML" is checked.



Determining the location of your image file

Once you upload your image to your course space locate it in the **File Manager** and click on the **ActionLinks** icon next to the file name.

Then, select **View File HREF**.



A separate window will open up which will provide you with the **HREF** of the image. The HREF is the path to the location of the file on the server.

Copy the HREF, paste it into the SRC attribute in your HTML code and the file should now display on your homepage!
